

Establishing a scholarship fund with Noblesville Schools Education Foundation offers a permanent legacy for donors and a lasting impact for NSEF community. Scholarships are a direct investment in someone's future. We are so appreciative that you are considering a scholarship partnership with NSEF. This agreement is designed to help guide the process and conversation as we finalize the details of your scholarship.

#### **NSEF NEW SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST**

- Thoughtfully consider the purpose of this scholarship. Are you seeking to honor someone special? Establish a memorial? Promote a specific field or industry? Support a specific population, club, sport, or characteristic?
- Review the NSEF application at www.noblesvilleschools.org/foundation. NSEF administered scholarships utilize a
  common application process online. Donors/scholarship representatives establish eligibility criteria that will be
  included through that application for each scholarship.
- Review the NSEF selection process. Typically, donors do not participate in the selection process due to potential
  and/or perceived conflict of interest as well as tax implications. In some situations, scholarship representatives or
  donors may elect to participate in this process or a separate process. Donors must comprise less than 50% of the
  selection committee. For scholarships that do not utilize the NSEF selection process, please list all the committee
  members in a separate document and attach to this agreement. Update the Foundation each year if that selection
  committee changes.
- Donors have choices in establishing scholarship and other restricted funds:
  - NSEF partners with the Hamilton County Community Foundation (CICF) to support endowed funds. These
    funds are the most permanent and lasting commitment to our mission. HCCF named on behalf of NSEF are
    restricted for Foundation use and are, therefore, protected by donor choice. HCCF manages the principal
    and allocates an annual spendable amount, typically 5%, for scholarship awards. Endowed funds are
    required to meet a minimum threshold.
  - Donors may also choose to invest funds directly with NSEF. NSEF will draw on these funds to award scholarships. NSEF maintains a restricted account separate from our operation account to ensure designated funds do not comingle with general funds.
  - o In some situations, NSEF may choose to accept "pass through" donations. If this is an area of interest for you, please notify an NSEF representative.
- Donors typically receive substantial tax benefits for establishing scholarship funds. Donors are encouraged to confer with tax advisors.

- 6. This fund is open ended and can be added to at any time. All subsequent additions will be administered using the same guidelines mentioned here. While funds remain, each spring NSEF will promote the scholarship, process applicants, select and notify recipients, and disburse funds according to NSEF policies. Established funds are irrevocable.
- 7. On rare occasions, circumstances arise that make it illegal or impossible to use the funds as specified, an appropriate recipient cannot be identified, and/or a scholarship check is returned. In this event, NSEF will attempt to communicate the issue to the Donor/Scholarship Representative and may submit a request for modification of the purpose. In the event NSEF cannot reach Donor/Scholarship Representative, the modification request will be submitted to the NSEF Board of Directors. In general, please indicate your preference:

Return the award to specific fund and forego annual award

Allow NSEF to select a comparable recipient

Allocate annual award to greatest education need of NSEF

8. NSEF has Donor/Scholarship Representative's permission to announce and acknowledge this gift. The





Donor/Scholarship Representative is encouraged to provide detail of any information supporting this gift including but not limited to, bios of donors, memorials, or honorees. Please communicate to NSEF if you prefer to be anonymous.

- 9. An endowed fund established is intended to award a scholarship in perpetuity. If this particular scholarship is not endowed, at some point the designated fund under NSEF will be dissolved. A designated scholarship fund is a temporary fund for the purpose of receiving contributions toward a specific scholarship. The designated fund account will continue until all designated money is disbursed from the fund. If there are any unused funds, these will be combined into NSEF's general unrestricted account at the discretion of the NSEF Board of Directors.
- 10. In order to support our organization and software for scholarship management, NSEF will charge a \$25 flat administrative fee each year we manage the fund and give out the award.
